Dear Foxhall Community and Community Working Group,

We hope this finds you and your family safe and healthy and that you are having a good school year.

As you all are aware, DC Public Schools (DCPS) transmitted the Community Working Group's recommendations for the school at Foxhall Rd back in June 2021. We are writing to share that a final decision has been made regarding the use of this space. The new school will be an elementary school serving PK4-5th grade. This will require drawing a new boundary that re-assigns portions of the Key, Mann and Stoddert boundaries, and developing a phase-in approach for when these changes would go into effect for impacted schools.

With the release of Mayor Bowser's Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) budget for Fiscal Year 2023 to Fiscal Year 2028, DC Public Schools (DCPS) is also reaching out to ensure the community is updated. **We are pleased to share that the Mayor's proposed budget includes the remaining funding for the Foxhall construction in Fiscal Year 2023.** DCPS and the DC Department of General Services (DGS) complete modernization projects in three years, with one year of planning and design, and two years of construction. The school will begin planning and design toward the end of Fiscal Year 2022, and the project will now be complete for School Year 2025-2026, an adjustment from the previously communicated timeline for School Year 2024-2025. *Please note, the budget development process is still underway and subject to adjustments.*

Throughout the modernization, DCPS will continue to share information with the community and offer opportunities to provide feedback. We appreciate your continued engagement in this process. We look forward to partnering with you to support DC students with a world-class education in modernized facilities.
